



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Achievements of the Research and Innovation Committee

Research and Innovation Committee, has following major achievements

1. Strengthening of Institutional Research Culture

The Committee successfully promoted a vibrant research culture among faculty members, postgraduate scholars, and undergraduate students. Monthly research review meetings, journal clubs, and departmental research presentations were conducted regularly. Faculty members were encouraged to undertake evidence-based Ayurvedic research, resulting in a significant increase in research proposals and academic discussions across departments.

2. Capacity Building and Research Skill Development

A series of workshops, seminars, and Continuing Medical Education (CME) programmes on research methodology, biostatistics, scientific writing, literature review, and Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) were organized. More than 80% of teaching faculty and postgraduate scholars participated in these activities, enhancing their competence in conducting quality research and preparing scientific manuscripts.

3. Promotion of Research Publications and Scholarly Activities

The Committee facilitated and monitored scholarly output, leading to a notable increase in publications in peer-reviewed and indexed journals. Faculty members and postgraduate students collectively published research articles, review papers, and case studies related to Ayurveda and integrative healthcare. Participation in national and international conferences also increased, with several papers receiving appreciation and awards.

4. Student Research and Innovation Engagement

Research orientation programmes and student innovation activities were introduced to cultivate scientific temper among students. Undergraduate and postgraduate students actively participated in research projects, poster presentations, and scientific competitions. A Student Research Forum was established to encourage young researchers to undertake innovative projects related to Ayurvedic principles, medicinal plants, public health, and clinical practices.


5. Establishment of Research Governance and Quality Assurance Mechanisms
