Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter no. L-14014/248/2020 EP-1 dated 09.02.2021 vide which conditional permission was conveyed to the said college with 54 seats in UG (BAMS) course (instead of 100 UG seats) and 01 PG course Kaumarabhritya with 05 seats and denial of 08 PG courses namely (i) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi Vaidyaka, (ii) Panchkarma (iii) Shalya Tantra, (iv) Ayurved Samhita siddhant (v) Rachana sharir (vi) Swasthavritta (vii) Dravyaguna and (viii) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana with 05 seats in each courses for the A.Y. 2020-21.

The reason for the college being not considered for total intake capacity of 100 UG seats and 08 PG courses for the AY 2020-21, as per Regulation 3 of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulation, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, IMCC Post graduate Regulations (Ayurveda) 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made there under and as per approved Standard Operative procedures (SOPs) and policies, is due to the following deficiencies:
